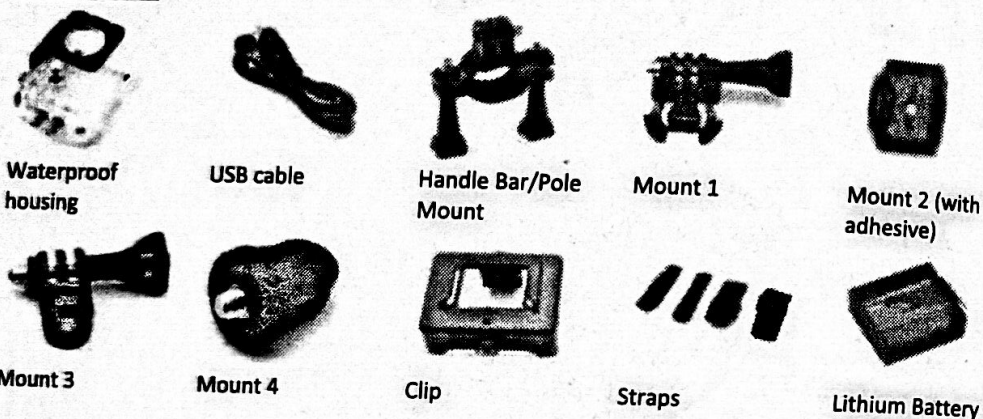
- Keep the unit away from extreme heat sources.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Installing the Battery

1. Slide the battery cover lock towards the arrow indicator next to it.
2. Take off the battery cover. Install the lithium battery as per indicated polarity.
3. Replace the battery cover, securely.

Charging the Battery

1. Connect the USB Cable (included) to the Micro USB Port of the Camera. And connect the other end of the cable either to a computer USB Port or another suitable power source. While charging is in process, Charging Indicator turns Blue and it turns off when the battery is fully charged. Usually, it takes about 4 hours to fully charge the battery.


Note: Camera can be charged even when it is powered off.

Installing the Memory Card

1. Insert Micro SD Card (included) into the Micro SD card slot till entirely inserted.
2. To take the Micro SD card out, gently press the end of the memory card inwards, the card will eject out.

Note: The camera is not equipped with built-in memory, and therefore, a memory card is required all the time.

Power On/Off

1. Power On: Press and hold power switch for 3 to 5 seconds to turn it on.
2. Power Off: Press and hold power switch for 3 to 5 seconds to turn off the camera.
Automatic power off: Camera turns off automatically, when it reaches the idle time set up by the user.
3. Power-off due to low battery: In case of extremely low battery,  icon may appear on the LCD screen. The camera will then automatically power off. Please recharge the battery.

Switching Between Modes

The camera is equipped with three modes: Video, Capture (still pictures) and Playback mode. Once the camera is powered on, the modes can be switched with Mode Switch.

Video mode: Records videos;

Capture mode: Clicks pictures;

Playback mode: Plays back recorded Videos and Pictures.

Indicators

LED Indicators; turn Red, when the camera is in video recording mode;

Charging Indicators; turn Blue when the camera is charging

Video mode

Push the Mode button to switch to Video mode. Click OK button to start recording. Click OK button again, to stop recording. Camera will automatically stop recording in case if the battery is too low.

00:00:01: Time-indicator; indicates duration of current recording;



: Mode Icon; indicates current mode as Video Recording mode;



: Exposure; indicates the current exposure setting;



: Loop Recording; indicates the current loop recording setting;



: Recording Quality; indicates the current recording quality is 1080P;



: indicates memory card has been inserted;



: Battery Icon; indicates current battery level;

Video menu setup

While in Video mode, press and hold OK button to open menu, and then press Up and Down button to select menu. When selecting menu, selected item gets highlighted. Press OK button to enter sub-menu. In sub-menu, press Up and Down button for selection, press OK button for confirmation and press Mode button to exit from the menu.

Capture mode

Push Mode button to switch to Capture Mode. Press Ok button once to click picture.

Capture menu setup

While in capture mode, press and hold OK button to open menu and then press Up and Down button to select menu. When selecting menu, selected item gets highlighted. Press OK button to enter sub-menu. In sub-menu, press Up and Down button for selection, press OK button for confirmation and press Mode button to exit from the menu.

Playback mode

After power-on, press Mode switch to Playback mode.

-  Mode icon; indicates its current mode as Playback Mode;
-  indicates that there is one file in current folder (the only folder);
-  indicates the current file is an AVI video file.

In playback mode, press Up and Down button to select the file. For video file, press OK button to play. Press OK button for pause/resume. Press Down button for fast forward or Up button for fast backward.

System setup menu

While in Capture or Video recording mode, press and hold OK button to open menu, and then press OK button again to switch over to Setup Menu. In Setup Menu, press Up and Down button for selecting menu. When selecting menu, background of the selected item will be highlighted. Press OK button to enter sub-menu. In sub-menu, press Up and Down button for selected, press OK button for confirmation, and press Mode button to exit from the menu.

Note: While inside the "Sounds" sub-menu, press the OK button each time for further selection menu. Press the Up and Down button each time for required setting. Press Mode button to go back to main menu. In the main menu, press Mode button again to exit from the menu.

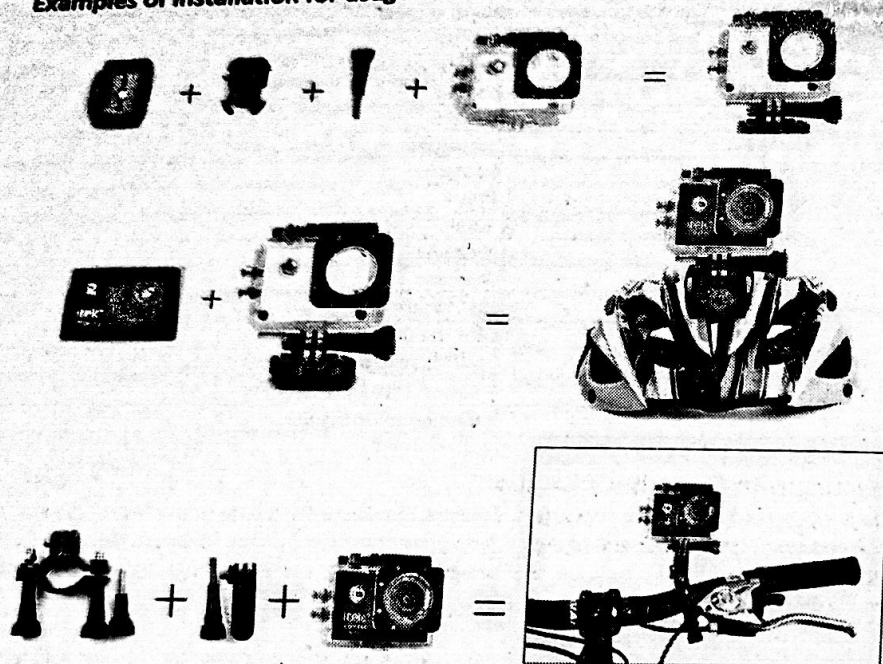

Connecting with Computer / Laptop

Camera is equipped to sync with computers. Connect USB Cable (included) to the Micro USB Port of the Camera, and connect the other end of the cable to your computer / laptop USB port. Once the Camera is connected to the computer, turn on the camera. Now the camera should appear under the removable devices on your computer.

You can now view the images / videos shot from your camera, on your computer. You can also move images / videos to your computer hard disk to free up space from the camera memory card.

Examples of installation for usage



- It is recommended that a commercial lens cleaner is used to prevent damage to the lens surface.
- This unit is best stored in a cool dry environment away from bright light and dust.
- Remove all media when storing the camera.
- Replace in packaging when dry and store in a cool dry place away from children.
- Uninstall battery and store it in a safe place, if camera is not intended to be used for an extended duration of time.

Care and maintenance

Read the following recommendations before using the device. Following these you will be able to enjoy the product for many years.

- The camera needs very little maintenance, however the casing may become slightly dirty. To clean, use a damp soft clean cloth and for stubborn stains, a small amount of detergent may be used on the case.
